Moreover you enjoy building relationships with some of the nation's best beef producers and helping them to grow their businesses.

We are 15km from Cracow township and if you have a partner seeking work the Cracow Gold Mine is often looking to recruit locals in admin, marketing or health roles as well as the traditional machinery

operators, drillers etc. Likewise, opportunities exist in Theodore in childcare, teaching, health and hospitality. We are three hours driving time from Rockhampton and seven hours from Brisbane.

With 35km of Dawson river frontage, including two weirs, a national park on our southern boundary and plenty of wildlife Gyranda is a natural playground for kids and adults alike. We work a solid 50 hour week, but weekends are normally your own.

Package includes wages plus 10% super, four weeks annual holiday and leave loading. Depending on circumstances it can also involve food, fuel, and vehicle.
